# **Martinsville Speedway:**

#### History

- Opened in September of 1947 by H. Clay Earles, Martinsville Speedway, originally a dirt track, is
  one of the oldest continuously-operating race tracks in the United States.
- The first NASCAR-sanctioned race at Martinsville was on July 4, 1948.
- The first Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series race was Sept. 25, 1949.
- The track was paved in 1955.
- The first 500-lap event at Martinsville was in 1956.
- Concrete corners were added atop asphalt in 1976.
- There have been 140 Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series races at Martinsville Speedway, one in the inaugural year and two races per year since 1950.

#### **Starts**

- A total of 626 different drivers have competed in at least one Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series race at Martinsville Speedway; 402 have competed in more than one.
- NASCAR Hall of Famer Richard Petty leads the Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series in starts at Martinsville Speedway with 67; followed by Dave Marcis and Ricky Rudd with 55 each.
- **Kurt Busch** leads the series in starts among active drivers at Martinsville Speedway with 37; followed by **Kevin Harvick** (35) and **Jimmie Johnson** (34).
- In total, 62 drivers have made their first career Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series start at Martinsville Speedway.
- Gray Gaulding (10/30/2016), Chase Elliott (03/29/2015) and Michael McDowell (3/30/2008) are
  the active drivers who have made their first Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series career start at
  Martinsville Speedway.
- **Fonty Flock** (nine starts) leads the Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series in average starting position at Martinsville Speedway with a 3.125.
- **Ryan Blaney** (six starts) leads all active drivers in the series in average starting position at Martinsville Speedway with a 7.833.
