- ▶ Chase Briscoe # (P) won the Pole Award for the 38th Annual Drive for the Cure 250 presented by Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Carolina with a lap of 83.232 seconds, 100.346 mph.
- ▶ This is his first pole in 45 NASCAR Xfinity Series races.
- ▶ This is his first pole and 20th top-10 start in 2019.
- ▶ This is his first pole in two races at Charlotte Motor Speedway Road Course.
- ▶ Tyler Reddick (P) (second) posted his 23rd top-10 start of 2019 and his second in two races at Charlotte Motor Speedway Road Course.
- ▶ Austin Cindric (P) (third) posted his second top-10 start at Charlotte Motor Speedway Road Course. It is his 24th in 28 races this season.
- ▶ Chase Briscoe (P) (first) was the fastest qualifying rookie.
