- Chase Elliott won the 50th Annual GEICO 500, his fourth victory in 123 Monster Energy Cup Series races.
- This is his first victory and third top-10 finish in 2019.
- This is his first victory and third top-10 finish in seven races at Talladega Superspeedway.
- Alex Bowman (second) posted his second top-10 finish in eight races at Talladega Superspeedway. It is his first top-10 finish in 2019. The runner-up finish is a career best for Bowman. His previous best was third at Pocono Raceway (July 29, 2018).
- Ryan Preece (third) posted his first top-10 finish in one races at Talladega Superspeedway. This was a career best finish for Preece. His previous best was eighth, in this year's Daytona 500.
- Ryan Preece (third) was the highest finishing rookie.
- ➤ Daniel Hemric finished fifth, his first career top-10 finish in 12 races. His previous career best was 18th at ISM Raceway (March 10, 2019).
- ➤ Kyle Busch leads the point standings by 15 points over Joey Logano.
- There were 39 lead changes, the most at Talladega since May 4, 2014 (48).
