- Kyle Larson won the Busch Pole Award for the 31st Annual Toyota/Save Mart 350 with a lap of 94.784 seconds, 95.712 mph.
- This is his eighth pole in 199 Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series races.
- This is his first pole and eighth top-10 start in 2019.
- ► This is his third consecutive pole (2017-2019) in six races at Sonoma Raceway. Larson ties Ricky Rudd (1990-1992) for the series-most consecutive poles at Sonoma with three each.
- William Byron (second) posted his ninth top-10 start of 2019 and his second in two races at Sonoma Raceway.
- Joey Logano (third) posted his fifth top-10 start at Sonoma Raceway. It is his 12th in 16 races this season.
- Ryan Preece (20th) was the fastest qualifying rookie.
