- Brad Keselowski won the Pole Award for the 50th Annual Consumers Energy 400 with a lap of 37.801 seconds, 190.471 mph.
- This is his 16th pole in 364 Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series races.
- This is his second pole and 13th top-10 start in 2019.
- This is his second pole in 21 races at Michigan International Speedway.
- Kevin Harvick (second) posted his 15th top-10 start of 2019 and his 18th in 38 races at Michigan International Speedway.
- William Byron (third) posted his first top-10 start at Michigan International Speedway. It is his 11th in 23 races this season.
- Matt Tifft (19th) was the fastest qualifying rookie.
