**Race Comments:** Before an estimated crowd of 140,000, Greg Biffle won the Batman Begins 400, posting his eighth NASCAR NEXTEL Cup Series victory. Prior to the green flag, the following drivers, under penalty, dropped to the rear of the field for the reasons indicated: #51 Kirby (engine change); #66 Garvey (transmission change); #8 Earnhardt Jr. (unapproved impound adjustment); #37 Lepage (unapproved impound adjustment).
