Race Comments: Before an estimated crowd of 100,000, Kurt Busch won the Pennsylvania 500, posting his 13th NASCAR NEXTEL Cup Series victory. Prior to the green flag, the following drivers, under penalty, dropped to the rear of the field for the reasons indicated: #15 Waltrip (unapproved impound adjustment); #38 Sadler (unapproved impound adjustment); #41 Mears (unapproved impound adjustment); #99 Edwards (driver change); .
