Race Comments: Before an estimated crowd of 105,000, Kurt Busch won the Subway Fresh 500, posting his 12th NASCAR NEXTEL Cup Series victory. Prior to the green flag, the following drivers, under penalty, dropped to the rear of the field for the reasons indicated: #37 Lepage (engine change); #7 R. Gordon (engine change); #4 M. Wallace (unapproved impound adjustment).
