Race Comments: Before an estimated crowd of 145,000, Jeff Burton won the Dover 400, posting his 18th NASCAR NEXTEL Cup Series victory. It is Burton's first NASCAR NEXTEL Cup victory since Phoenix in October 2001. Prior to the green flag, the following drivers, under penalty, dropped to the rear of the field for the reasons indicated: #10 Riggs (engine change); #32 Kvapil (engine change); #18 Yeley (backup car).
