Race Comments: Before an estimated crowd of 156,000, Jimmie Johnson won the UAW-DaimlerChrysler 400, posting his 20th NASCAR NEXTEL Cup Series victory. Prior to the green flag, the following drivers, under penalty, dropped to the rear of the field for the reasons indicated: #12 Newman (engine change); #19 Mayfield (backup car); #78 Wallace (backup car); #4 Wimmer (engine change).
