- ▶ Kevin Harvick won the 51st Annual Consumers Energy 400, his 55th victory in 704 NASCAR Cup Series races.
- ▶ This is his sixth victory and 19th top-10 finish in 2020.
- ▶ This is his fifth victory and 21st top-10 finish in 40 races at Michigan International Speedway.
- ▶ Denny Hamlin (second) posted his 15th top-10 finish in 30 races at Michigan International Speedway. It is his 14th top-10 finish in 2020.
- ▶ Martin Truex Jr. (third) posted his 13th top-10 finish in 30 races at Michigan International Speedway.
- ▶ Christopher Bell (17th) was the highest finishing rookie.
- ▶ This is Stewart-Haas Racing's sixth NASCAR Cup Series victory at Michigan International Speedway.
- ▶ Ford wins the Heritage Trophy in 2020 sweeping both races at Michigan International Speedway. Today's victory is Ford's 41st win at Michigan in the NASCAR Cup Series.
- ▶ Kevin Harvick becomes the first driver to win back-to-back races at the same track in consecutive days in the NASCAR Cup Series. The last driver to win a Cup races in consecutive days was NASCAR Hall of Famer Richard Petty in 1971 (7/14-15/1971 at Islip and Saratoga).
